

**THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE
SHERWOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT
January 8, 2013**

The regular meeting of the Sherwood Improvement District was held on Tuesday, January 8, 2013, at 6910 SW Fountaindale Road, Topeka, Kansas. Board members present were George Schuler, Rick Nesbitt and Bob Gast.

George Schuler called the meeting to order and welcomed those in attendance.

Officer De Jesus reported one mailbox damage and the recommendation that dog walkers wear reflective clothing.

Gerald Block spoke regarding the dirt piled on a Suffolk Street property with no erosion control. He also thanked the board for the removal of sand on that street.

Mary Swalwell and Bonnie and Gary Leeth attended the meeting to hear information on what the Sherwood Improvement District can do to help mediate the drainage problem relating to the Indian Hills Road tributary behind 2976-2980 Tutbury Town Road, which has changed its flow pattern. The board indicated they will inquire with the City of Topeka and Shawnee County for information on this matter but stated this area is not within the Sherwood Improvement District. Kevin Holland will contact Rich Eckert and resolution should happen this week.
