

**THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE
SHERWOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT
Provisional Minutes Pending Approval
January 10, 2017**

The regular meeting of the Sherwood Improvement District was held on Tuesday, January 10, 2017, at 6910 SW Fountaindale Road, Topeka, Kansas. Board members present were George Schuler, Rick Nesbitt and Bob Gast.

Also present were Kevin Holland (CFS Engineers), Lt. Tony DeJesus (Reserves Division of Shawnee County Sheriffs Office), Jim Crowl (Shawnee County Director of Human Resources) and Cathy Mosimann.

George Schuler called the meeting to order and welcomed those in attendance.

Lt. DeJesus presented the following patrol report:

- Shawnee County will do striping of the roads within the district
- Rock will be added to the north side of the road at the "finger" of Dukeries and Watling. Repair is needed or further eroding will affect the Improvement District's roadway
- A survey and drawings will be done to move ahead with the walking trail possibility on the north side of Nottingham from 33rd to 37th streets
- Review of the roadways for repair within the district will take place in March or April after sand is removed

NEW BUSINESS:

George Schuler was notified about a property on Gainsboro off 29th, which caught fire and potentially will not be repaired. The board will monitor this situation as to its potential ramifications with regard to nuisance regulations.

Rick Nesbitt moved to accept the new contract with the Shawnee County Sheriff's Office for the years of 2017, 2018 and 2019. The motion was seconded and carried.
