

**THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE  
SHERWOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT  
Provisional Minutes Pending Approval**

January 12,2021

The regular meeting of the Sherwood Improvement District was held on Tuesday, January 12, 2021, at 6910 SW Fountaindale Road, Topeka, Kansas. Board members present were George Schuler, Rick Nesbitt and Doug Mays.

Also attending were Kevin Holland (Cook, Flatt & Strobel, PA), Lt. Tony DeJesus (Reserves Division of the Shawnee County Sheriff's Office), James Crowl (Shawnee County Counselor), Joy & Steve Dodd (6830 SW Aylesbury Rd.) and Cathy Mosimann on phone taking minutes.

George Schuler called the meeting to order.

Officer DeJesus reviewed the statistics from the patrol report for the month of December. He stated things have been quiet in the district. There have been no issues with break-ins and Sheriff Hill will be sworn in next week.

Joy and Steve Dodd attended as Sherwood Lake Club representatives. They serve on the Lake Club's Lake Quality Environmental Commission (LQEC). There was discussion regarding the wattles on the district streets, which are for control of sand into the lake. The Lake Club will have watch zones to check wattle placement and whether they are reducing sand movement. Kevin will send a map with the location of the wattles within the district to the Dodds. Rick read a letter he received from property owner, John James, on Falcon, who expressed his opinion on the appearance of the wattles. Rick has received numerous calls about them. The board will look into how to address questions about keeping the sand out of the lake. At this time, this is the easiest and least expensive solution and the board noted it should be given a chance to work.

There was no meeting held in December 2020.
