

**THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE  
SHERWOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT  
February 11, 2014**

The regular meeting of the Sherwood Improvement District was held on Tuesday, February 11, 2014, at 6910 SW Fountaindale Road, Topeka, Kansas. Board members present were George Schuler, Rick Nesbitt and Bob Gast.

Also present were Kevin Holland (CFS Engineers), Officer Tony DeJesus (Shawnee Co. Sheriff's Reserve Department), Cathy Nesbitt, Jim Crowl (Shawnee County Counselor) and Cathy Mosimann.

George Schuler called the meeting to order and welcomed those in attendance.

Tony DeJesus presented the patrol report as follows:

- A pump station on Robins Drive was hit by a car and sustained a lot of damage. The driver left the scene but he's since been caught.
- No other news to report

Rick Nesbitt moved to approve the meeting minutes for the month of January 2014. The motion was seconded and approved.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

Kevin Holland reported on the following:

- 2014 road repair project will be ready about the middle of March with the bids being received at the April meeting. A drive through the district will be done during a special meeting of the board the first week of March to determine areas of need.
- New signs will replace some faded ones within the district in the month
- A check for \$2500 was received from Verizon and deposited into Kaw Valley Bank
- There is an erosion issue on Suffolk from work done by Shawnee County's sanitary sewer replacement. The cost would be \$600-\$700. Jim Crowl stated that Public Works should be contacted to address a resolution, as a first step.

Bob Gast reported that the eblast notification system will be up and running before the next board meeting in March. Kevin Holland will be the person who notifies DogLegs.Com

to publish the blasts. Efforts to sign more people will continue. Kevin would like future eblasts to report the need for off street parking, if possible, when snow occurs. This is particularly necessary when two cars are parked across the street from each other during this kind of weather. Mission Township has been told not to plow those areas of the streets under those conditions.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Jim Crowl reported that lawsuits were filed today against a property on Gamwell and one on 33<sup>rd</sup> in accordance with the newly established Nuisance Resolution for the Sherwood Improvement District. The legal process will be followed. He asks to be informed if any other issues need to be addressed.
