

**THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE
SHERWOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT
February 12, 2013**

The regular meeting of the Sherwood Improvement District was held on Tuesday, February 12, 2013, at 6910 SW Fountaindale Road, Topeka, Kansas. Board members present were George Schuler and Rick Nesbitt.

Also present were Kevin Holland (Cook, Flatt & Strobel Engineers), Onis Lemon (Mission Township), Dean Stowe (Mission Township), Chief Forrest Walter (Mission Township Fire Department), Jeff Lolley (Bartlett & West Engineers), Tom Vlach (Director Shawnee County Public Works), Lt. Danny Lotridge (Shawnee County Sheriff's Department) and Reserve Officer Tony De Jesus (Shawnee County Sheriff's Department).

George Schuler called the meeting to order and welcomed those in attendance.

Tony DeJesus spoke about the meeting at Farley Elementary School regarding the county's upcoming roadwork on Urish within the district.

Tom Vlach, Onis Lemon, Dean Stowe and Chief Walter spoke to the board, also, with regard to the upcoming roadwork on Urish between 33rd and 29th Street, which is to begin March 11, 2013. They addressed the issues of safety for the public and the ability of the fire trucks to enter and exit the station during the roadwork.

Lt. Lotridge spoke with regard to this project and the emphasis on public safety during this time frame. He indicated officers would be enforcing a zero tolerance for speeding and stop sign infractions during this time.

Jeff Lolley spoke of the upcoming roadwork on 37th Street between Walgreens (at the corner of Wanamaker and 37th) and French Middle School on Fairlawn. This work will begin March 18th and proceed in stages until Thanksgiving 2013.

Rick Nesbitt moved to approve the minutes from the January 2013 meeting. The motion was seconded and approved.

Rick Nesbitt moved to approve the financial report for the month of January 2013 and the following bills for payment. The motion was seconded and approved.

NEW BUSINESS:

A motion was made by Rick Nesbitt to adopt the following resolution for the time frame beginning March 11, 2013, until completion of said roadwork by Shawnee County on Urish Road. The motion was seconded and approved.

Resolution:

- 1. Close Urish Road to through traffic between the east entrance of Dillon's on Urish Road south to 33rd Street.**
- 2. Install 25 MPH signage on Mowbray Road and Gisbourne Lane.**
- 3. Install NO PARKING signage on one side of Staffordshire Road, one side of Gisbourne Road and one side of Hamptonshire Lane.**

Kevin Holland recommended holding off on road repairs for the district until August 1st. There should be a separate bid for sand removal from the road repair project for 2013.

There was discussion about Verizon's proposed contract with the Sherwood Improvement District for cell service on the water tower.
