

**THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE
SHERWOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT
March 13, 2012**

The regular meeting of the Sherwood Improvement District was held on Tuesday, March 13, 2012, at 6910 SW Fountaindale Road, Topeka, Kansas. Board members present were George Schuler, Rick Nesbitt and Bob Gast.

Also present were Kevin Holland (Cook, Flatt & Strobe), Cathy Mosimann, Gene Hicks (6760 SW Dancaster Rd.), Tom & Pat Thomas (3601 SW Kings Forest Rd.) and Tony DeJesus of the Shawnee County Sheriff's Department Reserves Division.

George Schuler called the meeting to order and welcomed those in attendance.

Tom Thomas attended to ask the board about striping Kings Forest in front of his property. He has submitted pictures to both the sheriff's representative and the board showing drivers cutting the corner of this street, which he feels is dangerous. The board indicated they are reviewing the streets within the district that are in need of striping and will review that street.

Tony DeJesus reported that he has asked deputies to watch the driving on Kings Forest. He reported mailbox damage on Canterbury Town Road and that Washburn Rural High School prom is April 21st and graduation is May 20th. Bob Gast has asked him to research accidents within the district over the last five years.

Bob Gast moved to approve the minutes of the February 2012 meeting. The motion was seconded and carried.

Cathy Mosimann reported that the Kaw Valley warrant, M-05-12, was voided and not paid, as it had been signed out of the incorrect account. After further discussion, it was decided not to reissue that warrant.

Rick Nesbitt moved to approve the corrected financial report for the month of January 2012 and the financial report for February 2012, as well as the following bills for payment. The motion was seconded and carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

Kevin Holland reported on the following:

There is still some work remaining from the 2011 road repair and will be completed shortly.

The 2012 road repair is out for bid at this time and due to Cook, Flatt & Strobel by the end of this month. Bids will be opened at the April board meeting. The board will hold a special meeting on Friday, April 6th at 3:00 p.m. at Cook, Flatt & Strobel to prioritize the areas in need of repair, which will include both asphalt and concrete issues with curb repair. Repair of road signage is forthcoming. Kevin indicated he can be contacted by area residents about signage concerns at kholland@cfse.com. He will wait a few more months before looking into sight distance concerns. Drainage issues are still a little wet to examine. Paint striping will be reviewed along with other road improvements. The board indicated they'd like to get to this issue as soon as possible.
