

**THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE
SHERWOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT
Provisional minutes pending approval**

May 9, 2017

The regular meeting of the Sherwood Improvement District was held on Tuesday, May 9, 2017, at 6910 SW Fountaindale Road, Topeka, Kansas. Board members present were George Schuler, Rick Nesbitt and Bob Gast.

George Schuler called the meeting to order and welcomed those in attendance.
