

**THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE
SHERWOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT
Provisional Minutes Pending Approval
May 11, 2021**

The regular meeting of the Sherwood Improvement District was held on Tuesday, May 11, 2021, at 6910 SW Fountaindale Road, Topeka, Kansas. Board members present were George Schuler, Rick Nesbitt and Doug Mays.

Also attending were Lt. Tony DeJesus (Reserves Division of the Shawnee County Sheriff's Office), Steve Dodd (6830 SW Aylesbury Ln.) and Cathy Mosimann.

George Schuler called the meeting to order.

Officer DeJesus reviewed the statistics from the patrol report for the month of April. He reported that Chelmsford has no 25 MPH sign. Also, they are watching the end of school year activities. The board stated that the Sheriff is welcome to attend a board meeting at any time.

Mr. Dodd attended as a Sherwood Lake Club representative. He said the Lake Club wants to talk to the Sherwood Improvement District board about the use of the wattles. They also want to discuss the use of sand and salt on the roads when there is ice and snow. He said he would notify the Lake Club of the date of the next SID board meeting on June 8.

Rick Nesbitt moved to approve the minutes of the April 2021 board meeting. The motion was seconded and carried.

Rick Nesbitt moved to approve the April financial report and the following May bills for payment with the exception of the Bettis bill, which needs to be adjusted to reflect only Sherwood's part owed for the work with the wattles. The other half should be billed directly to Sherwood Lake Club. The motion was seconded and carried. Cathy will adjust the Bettis bill according to the motion. The corrected amount shows below.
