

**THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE
SHERWOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT
May 14, 2013**

The regular meeting of the Sherwood Improvement District was held on Tuesday, May 14, 2013, at 6910 SW Fountaindale Road, Topeka, Kansas. Board members present were Rick Nesbitt and Bob Gast.
