

**THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE

The regular meeting of the Sherwood Improvement District was held on Tuesday, June 9, 2015, at 6910 SW Fountaindale Road, Topeka, Kansas. Board members present were George Schuler, Rick Nesbitt and Bob Gast.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

Kevin Holland reported on the following:

- Road repair – patchwork from Friar to Lancelot on King Arthurs Ct. will be the next area repaired. Concrete work will probably begin in September.
- Site distances - neighbors have alleviated a problem area
- Drainage areas – Discussion on three areas: 3901 to 3951 Canterbury Town Rd., 3810 SW Dukeries, and Gisbourne and Tutbury Town roads intersection. Kevin is working on budgeting the projects and will put them out for bid.
- Signage – 25 MPH speed zone signs will be installed on Lagito and El Cerito.

Nuisance ordinance proceedings as discussed with Jim Crowl include:

- The final cost of razing the property on 7171 SW 33<sup>rd</sup> Street is \$7900 and will be acted upon immediately.
