

**THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE  
SHERWOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT  
Provisional minutes pending approval  
August 13, 2019**

The regular meeting of the Sherwood Improvement District was held on Tuesday, August 13, 2019, at 6910 SW Fountaindale Road, Topeka, KS. Board members present were George Schuler, Rick Nesbitt and Doug Mays.
