

**THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE
SHERWOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT
September 11, 2012**

The regular meeting of the Sherwood Improvement District was held on Tuesday, September 11, 2012, at 6910 SW Fountaindale Road, Topeka, Kansas. Board members present were George Schuler, Rick Nesbitt and Bob Gast.

George Schuler called the meeting to order and welcomed those in attendance.

There were no public comments.

Officer Laub reported on various patrol issues within the district:

- Cases pending in vandalism of area mailboxes

- The drainage issue on Chelmsford will be addressed this fall within the next couple of weeks.
