

**THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE  
SHERWOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT  
November 8, 2011**

The regular meeting of the Sherwood Improvement District was held on Tuesday, November 8, 2011, at 6910 SW Fountaindale Road, Topeka, Kansas. Board members present were President, George Schuler, Vice-President/Secretary, Rick Nesbitt and Treasurer, Bob Gast.

Also present were Cathy Mosimann, Kevin Holland, Suzy Josserand-Hicks & Gene Hicks (6760 SW Dancaster Rd.), Gerald Block (6466 SW Suffolk), Onis Lemon and Dean Stowe of Mission Township.

George Schuler called the meeting to order and welcomed those in attendance.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS:**

- Gerald Block asked about what further erosion control would be done on 40<sup>th</sup> Street at the new box culvert. Kevin Holland stated that a silt fence is in place on the down stream side until vegetation growth. George Shuler said the Sherwood Improvement District will be mindful of any future problems and work to correct them with regard to erosion.

Tony DeJesus and Major Blume were present from the Reserves Division of the Sheriff's Office. He encouraged homeowners to check for proper credentials if someone comes to their door. The board asked him if the Sheriff's Department could put suggestions for property owners in the Gazette.

Dean Stowe and Onis Lemon from Mission Township attended to discuss the water line work being done on 41<sup>st</sup> Street. They indicated they were told that the improvement district had given permission to cut the road, of which they own half. George addressed them saying he received a call and was told that was what the city was going to do. He did not give permission. Rick Nesbitt suggested that both governmental entities contact whoever makes these decisions regarding this project and inform them of the situation so it does not happen again. There was additional discussion regarding Mission's use of the micro seal product on their roads to which they stated they are holding up very well so far.

Bob Gast moved to approve the minutes of the October 2011 meeting. The motion was seconded and carried.

Rick Nesbitt moved to approve the treasurer's report for October 2011 and the following bills for payment. The motion was seconded and carried.
