

**THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE

The regular meeting of the Sherwood Improvement District was held on Tuesday, November 11, 2014, at 6910 SW Fountaindale Road, Topeka, Kansas. Board members present were George Schuler, Rick Nesbitt and Bob Gast.
