

**THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE
SHERWOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT
Provisional minutes pending approval**

November 12, 2019

The regular meeting of the Sherwood Improvement District was held on Tuesday, November 12, 2019, at 6910 SW Fountaindale Road, Topeka, KS. Board members present were Rick Nesbitt, George Schuler and Doug Mays.

Also attending were Kevin Holland (Cook, Flatt & Strobel, PA), Captain Danny Lotridge and Tony De Jesus (Shawnee County Sheriff's Department), Ramon Powers (7121 Wattling Court) and Cathy Mosimann

Rick Nesbitt called the meeting to order and asked for the Patrol Report. Tony DeJesus reported on the activity within the district during the last month. They will be looking at package theft from front porches and remind drivers to stop when approaching school buses from either direction. Captain Lotridge reported that the WEBCo office building will be the outpost for the Sherwood Improvement District and a garage space will be leased for a patrol car and it should be operational by the end of November. Their primary focus will be on weekends but if they see trends in crime spikes, they'll change focus.

Rick spoke about the importance of the Sheriff's Department being in communication with the Sherwood Improvement District board. He also said he's provided Jim Crowl with the past Sheriff/Sherwood Improvement District contract and asked for revisions. He's hoping to have something at the end of the week. Tony will continue as the liaison to the district.

Ramon Powers attended to address an easement area drainage/erosion issue on Wattling Court. Kevin and the board will do a check on the area and stay in touch with Mr. Powers.
